

Ask why they don't shoot women

Four hundred and sixty two people have been shot by police over the last 20 years in Canada, 12 women, (3%). 50 years of research shows Police kill when disrespect escalates to a threat.

Men are pushier and tend to interrupt, women tend to be empathetic listeners. Men commit 90 % of the homicides and more than 85% of the serious crimes and that is why men, mostly white, get shot 98% of the time.

Indigenous and Black men are at the lowest absolute risk of being shot yet they are shot by police more often in proportion to their population. 6/10 police chiefs in Canada's large metropolitan areas being black will not change the fact that the reason for a higher proportion of shootings is behavior of those shot, not the police.

Self-control, maintaining the harmony of the family, thinking of others before yourself will keep you out of trouble. Asians who account for 10% of Canada's population and <1% of police shooting are evidence of this.

We are all descendants of serfs or slaves, victims of genocide, persecution and have been pushed off our land as we developed capitalism. We are all survivors. Being part of a tribe listening to rocks and the wind is part of everyone's past. That past does not justify narcissistic actions today; that's a tough lesson when the corporate media sensationalizes skin colour.

Our struggles are class struggles, the media plays up race shootings using relative risk statistics when absolute risk is all that matters and they do it at the behest of their corporate owners. The ruling class does not want the rabble thinking about progressive change, they want you squabbling about an issue that can not be resolved, at the bottom of the barrel while the plunder continues.
